



**Minden Gardnerville Sanitation District
District Manager's Report
October 2009**

1. EDU allocations: 5.0 EDU's were allocated during the month of September.
2. Digester Expansion Project: The sandblasting and recoating of the floating cover on Digester # 2 has commenced and barring any unforeseen difficulties, is expected to take approximately 3 weeks for completion.
3. Garage Building: As of October 1, we are still awaiting word from Douglas County pertaining to the flood plain issues have been delaying the project. We have met with building officials on site and were told that the issues appear to be minor and should be resolved. However, at this time, we are still awaiting approval.
4. Effluent Disposal: We discharged 7.0 MG/ 21.4 AC FT of effluent during the month of September.
5. Carson Valley Inn: The Carson Valley Inn has submitted plans for a casino expansion and remodel in which they are to relocate some existing drains. In accordance to the plans presented, no additional drains will be installed. A walkthrough of the facility was conducted on 9/15 to determine the actual EDU requirements. The actual EDU requirements based upon the completed walkthrough are 222.95 EDU's. However, they are currently being billed for 199.7 EDU's, which leaves them with a deficit of 23.25 EDU's. After reviewing past files and minutes pertaining to the CVI, it cannot be determined where the discrepancies originated. MGSD legal counsel has reviewed the issue and will have an opinion for the upcoming meeting.
6. Stand-by Pay: Attached is an outline of proposed stand-by pay and requirements, which were discussed at the September meeting.
