1. EDU allocations: No EDU's were purchased during the month of May.
2. Grease Receiving/Co-Generation Project: The grease digestion project is now underway. The supplier of the generator system is recommending upgrades to some of the control equipment for the system. However, Paul Cockrell has some reservations about the necessity of the upgrades. Paul will be present at the meeting to discuss his opinions and give a status report. In addition, Bruce and I met with Reno Rendering regarding the process of the grease receiving and proposed contract obligations.
3. Annexation Request: On the upcoming agenda is the public hearing on the annexation request as discussed at the May meeting.
4. NDOT/Martin Slough project: Bruce Scott and I met with Douglas County Engineer Mahmood Azad regarding the proposed expansion of the Martin Slough culvert beneath Hwy. 395, of which the work will be on MGSD property.
