



**Minden Gardnerville Sanitation District  
District Manager's Report  
September 2009**

1. EDU allocations: 4.4 EDU's were allocated during the month of August.
2. Digester Expansion Project: The dewatering and cleaning of Digester # 2 is complete. While no apparent major concerns were noted within the digester, a final inspection of the gas dome lid itself is still in need of completion to determine if any additional rehabilitation of the digester is warranted.
3. Stone Creek: We received a letter from Peter Beekhof in regards to his request for an extension of the 73.6 EDU's which were previously purchased. He is scheduled on the upcoming agenda to discuss his request.
4. Effluent Disposal: We discharged 94.6 MG or 290 AC/FT of effluent from the reservoirs thru the 26<sup>th</sup> of August.
5. Televising Equipment: In light of the recently mandated requirement that MGSD now be required to locate sewer laterals, it may be beneficial to consider the purchase of televising equipment that would help facilitate the location process. In addition, additional cost savings can be realized if MGSD were to utilize the equipment to televise majority our main lines in the ongoing efforts of rehabilitation of the sewage collection system. Scheduled on the upcoming agenda are representatives from Weco Industries and Cues West to demonstrate and explain other options.
6. Special meeting request: R.O. Anderson has requested a special meeting to request abandonment of easements on the proposed Walmart site. They have requested tentative dates of the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>, or 17<sup>th</sup> of September.
